lower level of the visitor center. The plant sale starts at 9 am and runs to 1 pm. A variety of hardy perennials, annuals, garden treasures and red wiggler worms will be available. Master Gardeners and Master Naturalists will be available to answer your gardening questions. The Plant Sale is sponsored by the Brainerd Garden Club and Arboretum garden volunteers. The Garden Club has funded many gardens and building projects at the Northland Arboretum including benches, planters, obelisks, arbors, irrigation, numerous plants and shrubs, recycling bins, white board, and a projector screen, just to name a few. With financial support of the U of M Extension Crow Wing County Master Gardener grant and Brainerd Garden Club, a new Veteran's Memorial Picnic Pavilion will be built this summer by the old east entrance. Proceeds from this plant sale will help fund the restoration of the Rain and Pollination Garden planned this spring at the Northland Arboretum just across from the visitor center parking lot.
